



VISIT TO TATE MODERN

Monday 21st November

CEZANNE

A career-spanning survey of a pivotal figure in modern art



Join us at Tate Modern for a private lecture followed by a tour at your own pace of this new once-in-a-lifetime exhibition of paintings, watercolours and drawings by Paul Cézanne.

The EY Exhibition will bring together around 80 works from worldwide collections, giving UK audiences their first opportunity in over 25 years to explore the breadth of Cézanne's career and it will feature key examples of his iconic still-life paintings, Provençale landscapes, portraits and bather scenes, including over 20 works never seen in the UK before.

The exhibition will trace Cézanne's artistic development from a young ambitious painter from Aix-en-Provence and friendships with Camille Pissarro, Claude Monet and the Parisian art scene, to his later years in his native Provence, and it will spotlight the relationships central to his life, particularly his wife Marie-Hortense Fiquet and their son Paul, and his childhood friend Emile Zola.

Arrangements and Tickets

Members will need to make their own way to Tate Modern, Bankside, London SE1 9TG. It is approx. a 16 minute walk from both Waterloo and London Bridge BR stations, and 8 minutes from Blackfriars.

We will gather at **11.20 am** at The Starr Cinema on Level 1 (next door to the café which faces the river), then enter the lecture hall ready for a prompt start at **11.30 am**.

After the hour long lecture, tickets for the self-guided tours around the exhibition will be split into two groups, with entry at 12.45pm and 1.30 pm.
