



VISIT TO PASHLEY MANOR and GREAT DIXTER

TUESDAY 14th JUNE



Join us on a visit to the magnificent gardens of Pashley Manor and the historic house and gardens of Great Dixter.



Pashley Manor: following tea/coffee on arrival, we will have an introductory talk in front of the Manor House before being free to explore the many different areas of the 11 acres of gardens. All the ingredients of an English country garden are present - herbaceous borders, ha-ha, kitchen garden and an historic walled garden. We will be there just before Rose Week so there will be many varieties to see throughout the gardens. As we explore, you can also walk around the Old Moat and enjoy the wildlife and sculptures dotted around.

Lunch is NOT included. There is however a cafe which serves a variety of soup, quiche, pie, ploughman's, salads, cake, scones etc along with hot and cold beverages, including wine and beer. You could also take your own picnic and there are some picnic tables/ benches available.

Great Dixter: after lunch, we travel on to Great Dixter - the family home of Christopher Lloyd. We can visit the house built in the 15th century, then restored and enlarged by Sir Edwin Lutyens. In 1910, Christopher Lloyd's father commissioned Lutyens to remove the alterations that had been made in the intervening years. This revealed the medieval splendour of the Great Hall which is the largest surviving timber-framed hall in the country. The medieval Great Barn is open, as well as a Victorian oast and the White Barn with various displays. There is a gift shop, plant nursery and small cafe.

Our coach will leave from Upper High Street car park Epsom at 8.40am and we aim to return there about 6pm.

Tickets: The cost will be **£50** per person, which includes coach travel, driver's gratuity, tea/coffee on arrival and the introductory talk at Pashley Manor

Tickets will be on sale from **09.30 am** prior to our lecture on **Wednesday 6 April**. We will only accept payment by credit/debit card and tickets will be limited to two per member (both TASE members). We will not be selling online. In the event of your cancellation, refunds will only be made if places are later resold.
