



WADDESdon MANOR

Join us on a visit to the beautiful **Waddesdon Manor** a Grade 1 listed house built between 1874 and 1889 for Baron Ferdinand de Rothschild in a mostly Neo-Renaissance style, copying individual features of several French chateaux.

On arrival we take the shuttle bus from the coach park to the house. There will be time to view the stunning gardens or seek refreshment before we enter the Manor with timed tickets. Inside the house you can admire the rich decoration and the Rothchild's extensive collection of art and furniture, one of the most rare and valuable in the world. A new display shows the recently cleaned and restored "The Pink Boy" by Gainsborough, that can be viewed alongside three other Gainsborough works.

In addition to the house, you can visit the wine cellars, the Coach House Gallery, see rare birds in the aviary and wander the landscaped gardens. This year there is a site-wide exhibition "Alice's Wonderlands" which celebrates the life, legacy and collections of Alice de Rothschild. There is of course a gift shop, restaurant and café, or you might choose to take your own picnic.

We will leave from Upper High Street car park Epsom at 8.30am and we aim to return there about 6.30pm.

Tickets: The cost is **£18** per person for those who hold current membership of **National Trust, Art Pass, or Historic Houses** and **£40** for anyone else who is not a member of those organisations. This includes coach travel, driver's gratuity, and entrance fees. **You must bring your NT, Art Pass, or HH card on the day.**

Tickets will be on sale from **09.30 am** prior to our lecture on **Wednesday 1 June**. We will only accept payment by credit/debit card and tickets will be limited to two per member (both TASE members). We will not be selling online. In the event of your cancellation, refunds will only be made if places are later resold.
